GUIDELINES for PARTNERSHIP PASTORAL COUNCIL:

- 1. The Partnership Pastoral Council exists as a forum to prayerfully discern, promote and develop joint pastoral action within the Parish Partnership.
- 2. This joint pastoral action includes liturgical, spiritual and social aspects, as well as pastoral, in order to create new possibilities for mission and pastoral renewal¹.
- 3. The Archdiocesan Statement of Mission² will inform these joint activities, where encounter with the person of Jesus makes us who we are, and shapes all we do.
- 4. This Statement of Mission also provides the Vision and Values that can be developed across the partnership parishes. Key to this is working alongside each other to effect renewal.

GATHERINGS

- 5. Since this is a forum for discerning joint pastoral action, it is important that substantial time is spent in prayerful reflection following a synodal approach.
- 6. At these gatherings, planning for joint pastoral activities can take place, members being careful to listen and reflect together on needs expressed.
- 7. Each Partnership Pastoral Council is encouraged to create vibrant communities of faith with a view to deepening the partnership of parishes over a period of time.
- 8. Awareness of the need for responsible stewardship will be an important element to grasp, as well as the resources available of time, talent and treasure.
- 9. At these gatherings, it will also be important to engage with the Framework for Pastoral Renewal¹ and the twelve Informing Principles of *Building Hope* to guide pastoral activity.³

CHAIRPERSON

- 10. Each Partnership Pastoral Council will nominate a Chairperson, through a process of dialogue and discernment, to facilitate gatherings of the council and encourage follow-through on joint pastoral actions.
- 11. The Chairperson organises the gatherings of the Partnership Pastoral Council in accordance with the model discerned (See Pastoral Aid B).⁴
- 12. The term of service of the Chairperson will be no less than one year and no more than three years.
- 13. The Chairperson will prepare the agenda for the gathering, together with the members of the Partnership Pastoral Council.
- 14. The emphasis will be on pastoral activities which nourish the whole partnership. Other items that impact individual parishes are for the usual Parish Pastoral Council (PPC)⁵ to consider.
- 15. The Chairperson will also appoint a note-taker who will simply record decisions and named actions.
